



Newborn Screening Benefits Program Fact Sheet

Eligibility requirements:

- Infants, Children & Adults; prioritized by need as funds are available.
- Income at or below 350% of Federal Poverty Income Level
- Diagnosed with disorder identified by Newborn Screening Program
- Bona fide resident of the State of Texas
- No insurance and/or insurance does not cover requested vitamin, supplement, medication

Provides:

- Dietary Supplements (metabolic foods, low-protein foods)
- Medications
- Vitamins

Enrollment:

- Clinic Social Worker and/or Dietitian will assist families in completing the necessary paperwork for the program
- Once NBS application is turned in it will take several weeks for state office to review the application
- Once approved you will receive a letter from the state regarding approval for the program and listing the pharmacy that will be providing the requested vitamins, supplements, and/or medications

If you have not received a letter from the state and/or the requested vitamins, supplements, and/or medications within 30 days of completing your application please call the Clinic Social Worker (682-885-3991) or Dietitian (682-885-7496) so that we can follow up on your application.

Once you begin receiving your vitamins, supplements, and/or medications you will need to call the pharmacy if you move, receive the wrong items, or do not receive your items.
