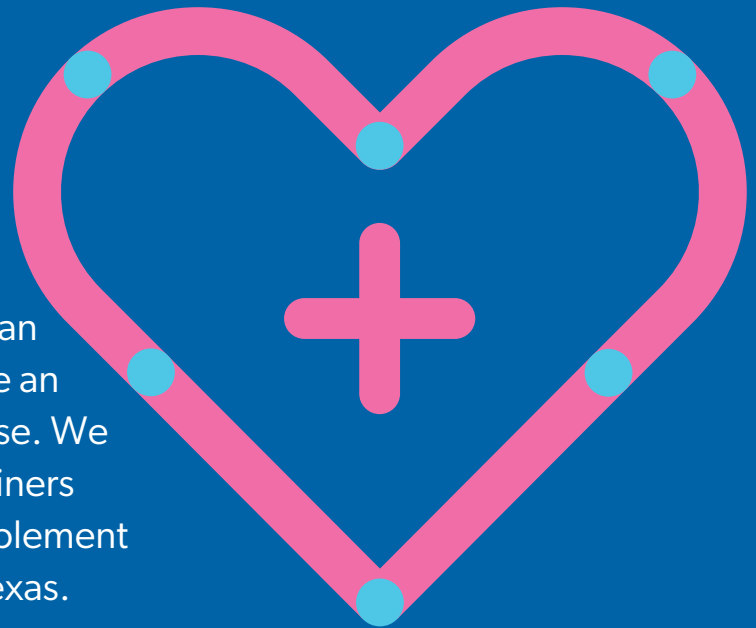


Lifesaving education and training

Our Project ADAM[®] Texas program at Cook Children's increases sudden cardiac arrest awareness and helps schools establish an emergency response team, plan and rehearse an AED drill to ensure a timely, lifesaving response. We educate school systems, nurses, coaches, trainers and parents on sudden cardiac death and implement public access defibrillator programs across Texas.



Free services offered:

- Hands-only cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training for school staff
- Automated external defibrillator (AED) training for school staff
- Assistance in conducting AED drills
- Heart Safe School designation



Free resources include:

- AED signage
- CPR training log and videos
- AED drill information and checklist
- Cardiac emergency response plan templates
- AED site assessment and budget planning documents
- Sudden cardiac arrest training script for employees
